



FINDING YOUR ALEKS PLACEMENT SCORE

What is ALEKS? What do I need my placement score for?


The ALEKS Placement Assessment is used to determine the mathematics course you are eligible to take. Students will not be able to register for a math class at Bentley unless they have earned a minimum score on the ALEKS Placement Assessment (or brought in prior math credit through AP, IB, etc.).

Navigating to ALEKS Placement Score

Step 1


Select the icon in the upper right corner and click View Profile below your name.



Step 2


If you are not a student employee at Bentley, you can skip this step.

Click on your hyperlinked name under the Student heading.




Step 3

Select Academics from the left menu.




Step 4

On your academic overview page, select the **External Records** tab.



Sten 5

Locate Math Placement (ALEKS PPL) in the "Education Test" column (it may be listed more than once if you took the placement exam multiple times). Identify your highest score and compare it to the course placement chart to see what math courses you are eligible to register for.



ALEKS Placement Score Chart

Identify the score range for your *highest* ALEKS score to determine which math courses you are eligible to register for.

ALEKS Score Range	Eligible Courses
81-100	MA131, MA131L, MA105 or MA107
76-80	MA131L, MA105 or MA107
61-75	MA105, MA105L, MA107 or MA107L
46-60	MA105L or MA107L
0-45	Utilize the Prep and Learning modules within ALEKS PPL and then retake the assessment.
