Important: Spring 2022 Registration

Please check the Academics section of Workday for your spring 2022 registration start date and time. If you have any questions about your registration time, please contact the Registrar's office at registrar@bentley.edu.

Course offerings for the spring term can also be found in Workday's Academics section, via the Bentley Find Course Sections link. A reminder to:

- use the filters on the left to streamline your search as it may be helpful
- confirm you meet the eligibility rules for intended courses
- review section-specific information for course focus requirements

A reminder to click **Process New** at the top of the audit every time to ensure you are seeing the most current information.

If you are not able to enroll in a course, you can add yourself to the waitlist (WL) once you have registered. Waitlists can be accessed via the link in the Announcements box at my.bentley.edu.

- Thurs. 12/9: last day for you to add yourself to a spring WL
- Fri. 12/17: WLs discontinued; you must use add/swap to try to enroll in a course if an opening becomes available

If you are eligible to take a sixth course in the spring, you can add that class starting November 19th. To be eligible to take a sixth course, you would need to have an overall GPA of 2.7 or above (or senior status with an overall GPA of 2.0 or above).

Seniors

By the end of your senior year, you should complete:

- GB 410
- remaining Gen Eds, major classes, and electives

Other things to consider/plan for:

- Completing all degree requirements including:
 - course focus requirements
 - if applicable: ASB/ASF, minor, Liberal Studies Major/Business Studies Major, Honors Program
- balancing academics with job search

Juniors

By the end of your junior year, you should complete:

- GB 310
- GB 320
- major courses
 - check prerequisites
 - balancing major classes over junior and senior year, if possible
- Gen Eds/electives

Other things to consider/plan for:

- a potential minor
- taking CDI 301 in the spring
- study abroad experience
- considering graduate school

Sophomores

By the end of your sophomore year, you should complete:

- EC 111, EC 112
- GB 213, GB 214, GB 215
- Gen Eds/elective
- major courses, once meeting prerequisites

Other things to consider/plan for:

- researching and deciding your major
- exploring study abroad programs and application process
- potential application to Advanced Standing in Business/Finance programs

First Years

By the end of your first year, you should complete:

- MA II
- EXP I or II
- GB 212
- IT 101 or GB 110 or PH 101
- Gen Eds

Other things to consider/plan for:

- CDI 101
- Campus involvement
- Study abroad research
- Interest exploration
- Time management
