Classes Will Be Held on President's Day

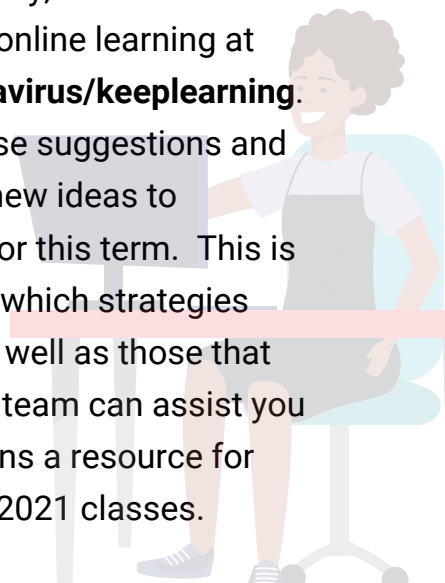
