

Choosing Your Courses

Students in the Honors Program should use the honor's version of this document. Transfer students should not use this document and refer to their Advising & Registration checklist.

Course 1: Math or CS 100

This course will be registered for you before registration day! You should build your schedule around the course. Courses will be assigned based on math placement and major. You can find this course in your Workday account or in your Schedule Planner by July 22nd.

- You will take Math and CS 100 in your first year.

- If you have prior in credit for MA 105, 107, or 131 - you will not need a math course unless you plan to pursue a math major.

Course 2: Business Dynamics

In your first two years at Bentley, you will take six Business Dynamics courses. For your first semester, you can choose between the following: LA 100 Business Law, MG 116 Human Dynamics in Organizations, or EC 111 Microeconomics.

- This course you should add to Schedule Planner yourself.
- Business Dynamics classes do not need to be taken in a particular order.
- The majors in the table below require Business Dynamics as pre-requisites to their courses, so you can choose to prioritize these if you see your intended major here.
- If you brought in 12 credits or more, you are eligible to choose from the three courses listed above or FI 118 Introduction to Finance or AC 115 Financial Reporting and Analysis.
- If you have prior in credit for any Business Dynamic, choose a different one.

Course 3: FDS 100 – Falcon Discovery Seminar

FDS 100 must be taken in your first semester. There are many topics you can choose from. We recommend reviewing the different topic options and choosing your top five.

- FDS 100 will be uploaded to your Schedule Planner. To select an FDS class section, ensure it is checked off on your Schedule Planner list. Once you have reviewed the topics, you can use Schedule Planner to show schedules with only your favorite topics. Course 4: EMS

EMS 101/101L/102/102L must be taken in your first semester. Your EMS course is based on your placement.

- Your EMS placement will be uploaded to your Schedule Planner. To select an EMS class section, ensure it is checked off in your Schedule Planner list. To filter your choices, you can use the options gear in Schedule Planner to see all EMS options.

- If you brought in credit for EMS 101, you should take EMS 104 instead.
