On or Around Registration

How do I know what to do before registration? How will I know what classes to take? How do I actually register?

Review the New Student Advising & Registration Website!

This website has a ton of helpful tools including a New Student Registration Checklist and resources that review everything related to the first-year registration process including what classes to take and how to enroll in them.

REMEMBER: You won't be able to register for your courses until your registration day on July 30th !

Can I change my major?

First-year students won't be able to change their major or add minors prior to the start of the fall semester. This should not have an impact on course registration.

Can I change my schedule after registering? When does my schedule need to be finalized by?

July 30th at 10am ET: Registration Opens

July 31st at 10am: ET Registration Closes

Once registration closes, students will not be able to make schedule adjustments

August 29th : Registration Re-Opens for Schedule Assistance

*Students can continue making schedule adjustments through the end of the Add/Swap period on **September 8th**.*

Were my AP, IB, etc. results received? What advanced standing credit did I earn?

How do I know who my advisor is? Can I schedule a meeting with them prior to registration?

At the start of the fall semester, first-year students will be assigned an academic advisor.

The best way to speak with an advisor about registration is to attend Registration Advising via Zoom and Registration Support via Zoom.

What if a class I want is closed?
