



Choosing Your Courses

Worksheet- Honors Program

Students who are not in the Honors Program and transfer students should not use this document and instead refer to the Advising & Registration Checklist.

COURSE 1: CS 100 OR MATH

In your first semester, you will take CS 100 or Math.

- For your first semester, you can choose to take either CS 100 or your Math course. Your math course options will be based on your math placement and declared major. You can view this course in your Workday.
- If you already have credit for MA 105, MA 107, or MA 131, you do not need to take a math course—unless you are planning to major in a math-department major (Actuarial Science, Data Analytics, Quantitative Economics, or Mathematical Sciences).

COURSE 2: FDS 100 HONORS

FDS 100 is required in your first semester.

There are several topic options to choose from, and we recommend reviewing them to find those that interest you.

- FDS 100 will be added to your Schedule Planner. **To select an HONORS section**, use the options gear icon in Schedule Planner to filter your FDS topics.

- FirstGen Presidential Fellows** must choose section 38 AND take an Honors section of different class (ex: EC 111/LA 100/MG 116 or Context & Perspectives course).
Global Women's Scholars must choose section 9 Honors.

COURSE 3: EMS 101 HONORS/102 HONORS

EMS 101 Honors or EMS 102 Honors is required in your first semester.

Your EMS course is based on your placement results.

- Your assigned EMS placement will appear in your Schedule Planner. To select a section, make sure it is checked in your course list. You can also use the gear icon in Schedule Planner to filter and view all EMS section options.
- If you have prior credit for EMS 101, please try to register for EMS 104H. If you are not able to enroll in EMS 104H for the fall, you will take that class in spring 2027. And you should select an Honors section of a second Business Dynamics or Context & Perspectives class to complete your fall schedule. *Honors students can not take a non-Honors section of EMS 104.*

COURSE 4: BUSINESS DYNAMICS

In your first two years at Bentley, you will take six Business Dynamics courses. For your first semester, you can choose between the following: [LA 100 Business Law](#), [MG 116 Human Dynamics in Organizations](#), or [EC 111 Microeconomics](#).

- You need to add one of these courses to your Schedule Planner list.
- If your intended major is listed in the table below, consider prioritizing the courses that are prerequisites for that major.
- If you have been awarded 12 credits or more**, you are eligible to choose from [FI 118 Introduction to Finance](#) or [AC 115 Financial Reporting and Analysis](#)
- If you have prior credit for any Business Dynamics, choose a different one.
