

# Advising 101: Course Focus Requirements

Before graduating, all Bentley students must satisfy the **Course Focus Requirements** by selecting courses from a list of approved options that have U.S. diversity, international, and communication intensive material as their focus. In order to graduate, students are required to take and pass:

- · one U.S. diversity-focused course
- · one international-focused course
- one communication-intensive course
- one communication-intensive course specifically designated in the major, for students pursuing a bachelor of science program



Transfer students entering Bentley with 30+ transfer credits are waived from course focus requirements.
