#### **Important DegreeWorks Reminders**

Once you have registered for fall classes, check DegreeWorks to confirm how those classes are applying to your degree requirements. Please pay careful attention to the newly renumbered NAS and EMS classes if they're intended to apply to the Literature, 4-credit Natural Science, Behavioral Science, or Math/Natural Science elective. This review should be done 24 hours after preparing/adjusting your fall schedule and you'll need to click Process New at the top of the audit to view the most current information.

Use the **What If** feature to review potential major/minor course requirements. Please make sure to include your catalog year. Your catalog year is the term you enrolled at Bentley. It is important to choose your applicable catalog year in order to view an accurate What If for your academic planning. By choosing the wrong catalog year, you are viewing information that may not apply to your degree requirements.



#### Did You Enroll at Bentley in Fall 2020?

If so, please declare your major in Workday. It is important to have your major declared to plan for future semesters and have an accurate DegreeWorks audit. You can use this <a href="Step-by-Step Guide">Step-by-Step Guide</a> to change your Program of Study (major) from Undecided Business/Liberal Arts to your desired major. If you are choosing a major in Finance, Management, IDCC, or Language, Culture, & Business, you need to select a concentration for the major to fully populate. The Registrar's office processes all Program of Study declarations, and it may take a few business days before you see the change in Workday or DegreeWorks.
