

Your Guide to Academic Programs Month

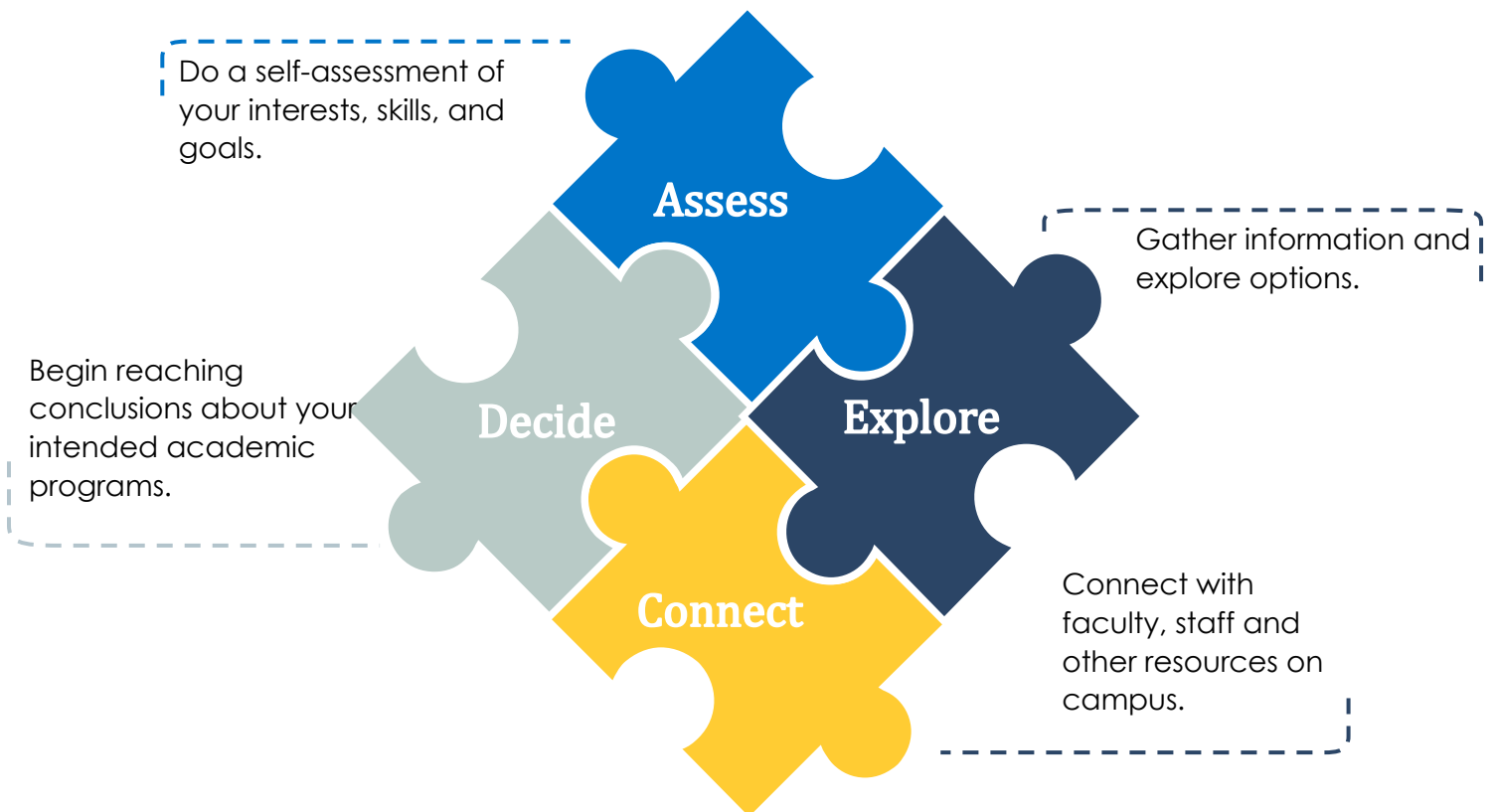
