Statement of Acknowledgment of Indigenous Peoples and their Ancestral Lands

Bentley University was founded and currently residents on the ancestral homelands of the indigenous Pawtucket (puh-TUCK-et) and Massachusetts (MASS-ad-CHU-sett) peoples, the latter from whom the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts was taken.
