Esther Tetreault is the owner and co-founder of Trillium Brewing Company, along with her husband JC. Since opening in the Fort Point neighborhood of Boston in 2013, Trillium has expanded to four active locations, including a production brewery in Canton, MA, a full-service restaurant and brewery in Fort Point, a greenhouse-inspired taproom in the Fenway neighborhood, and an open-air beer garden located in downtown Boston. Each year since opening, Trillium has been ranked among the Best Breweries in the World by RateBeer. In 2018. Esther and JC were nominated as James Beard Foundation Semifinalists for Outstanding Wine, Spirits, or Beer Professional. They were also named finalists for Empire Builder of the Year by Eater Boston in 2019. A seasoned business owner. Esther holds an MBA from Bentley's McCallum School of Business and sits on the Family Reach National Advisory Board.
