BACK TO BENTLEY: MOVE-IN PROTOCOL

Welcome to the spring 2021 trimester! To ensure a safe and seamless move-in experience, please follow the instructions below.

- When you arrive to campus, use the entrance at 175 Forest Street, not the Beaver Street entrance.
- At the stop sign, take a left and head towards the Adamian Academic Center, where move-in testing will be conducted. (See map location (a)
- Park in Lot 8 or Lot 9. Do not enter the Adamian testing site more than five minutes prior to your appointment. This may require you to wait in your car until your designated time. (See map location 1)
- Follow the screening testing signs to enter Adamian closest to Lindsay Hall.
- Check in with a staff member at the first table to verify all requirements are completed prior to screening/move-in.
- Once you've been checked in, you'll take your test and exit the building.
- You can then drive to your residence hall, where you'll check in with a Residential Center staff member.
- Please unload all items from your car within the 30 minutes allotted before moving your car to a proper parking location.

ADDITIONAL DETAILS

Students must be in compliance with all Massachusetts health and vaccine requirements including the flu shot, with documentation properly uploaded to the <u>Medicat</u> Student Health Portal.

Every student, regardless of which state they are coming from, must present a negative result from a molecular (PCR) test administered in the 72 hours before their scheduled move-in time. If a student does not show a negative result PCR COVID test on their designated move-in date, they will be required to self-quarantine at home or in a hotel until the on-campus test results come back, usually within 24-48 hours. This will be paid for by the student.

Students must be signed up for all weekly screening test appointments on campus for the entire spring term. The last week of screening testing will be the week of April 30, 2021.
