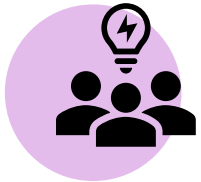


Key Concept: Hybrid, Synchronous, Asynchronous

- Hybrid: Class meets with professor and some students in classroom, some students live online
- Synchronous: Class meets in real time online
- Asynchronous: Students interact with professor, peers, and class materials online, not in real time

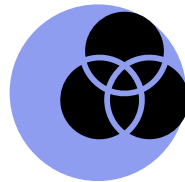
Design an Online or Hybrid Course

- Student-to-Student
- Student-to-Instructor
- Student-to-Material



Materials

- Blackboard LMS
- Publisher site (textbooks)



Communicate

- Blackboard Tools: Announcements, Wikis, Blogs, Journals, Discussion Board
- Zoom / MS Teams
- Virtual Office Hours



Feedback

Provide whole class and individualized feedback to students on a regular basis (course announcements, discussion threads, Gradecenter)
