How to Apply for Curricular Practical Training (CPT)

CPT is a work authorization for F1 visa holders to participate in internships during their program of study. Here are four steps to follow so you are able to work in the United States.



STEP 1

Secure an internship and obtain an employer offer letter.



STEP 2

Work with your internship coordinator and academic advisor to enroll in an internship course and complete the CISS' CPT Application (located on the CISS website).



STEP 3

Bring or email completed CPT Application to CISS. We will prepare a new I-20 (in 3-5 business days) giving you permission to work.



STEP 4

Once you have your new CPT I-20 from CISS you may begin working!
