Courses Reserved for Specific Majors/Minors/Concentrations

To ensure students are able to access <u>required</u> courses, below is a list of courses that are reserved for specific declared academic programs until November 14th.

If you are trying to register for these courses without the indicated academic program, you will be put on the waitlist for the course, even if the course status is open.

On November 14th, any open seats will be released to waitlisted students.

DO NOT RELY ON THE WAITLIST! There is no guarantee you will be offered a seat. At the time you register, you should fully register for five academic courses. If you get offered a seat in a waitlisted course, you can swap classes within your schedule.

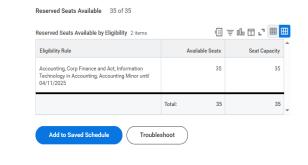
