Failure to abide by these guidelines will result in being dropped from incorrect course registrations

FAQ's for <u>all</u> Advanced Standing Program Students

- Only register for OPEN graduate course sections that you're eligible for.
- If a section is closed, don't add yourself to the graduate course waitlist. You will be removed.
- You <u>can't</u> take more than 4 total graduate courses in your Advanced Standing program during your undergraduate pathway. If you've already taken 4, don't register this semester.
- You <u>can't</u> register for courses you've already taken the UG course equivalences for.

- You <u>can't</u> register for GR 500 level foundation courses, BID, HF, or AL online course sections.

Accounting

New ASAC students - Register for the following:

- AC 611-1 take instead of AC 311.
- AC 730-1 take instead of AC 340

Review the graduate Accounting majors <u>here</u>. Knowing your intended major will be beneficial in your graduate course selections.

Business

For BS Majors:

Take **GR602-1** instead of CS 305 (or GB 310)

Take **GR604-1** instead of MG 300 (or GB410)

Take 2 MBA Electives instead of 2 Electives

For BA Business Studies Majors:

Take **GR601** instead of a Business Elective Take **GR602-1** instead of a Business Elective Take 2 MBA Electives instead of 2 Electives

Business Analytics

The four graduate courses are: MA610, ST625, CS605, and MA705.

ST625 replaces MA252; CS605 replaces CS350; MA705 replaces MA346.

If MA252 is a major/minor requirement, take ST625 junior year.

Finance

You can only register for **Finance** courses that apply to your program tract. Review the catalog <u>here</u>.

FinTech majors:

The four graduate courses options are: FI 623, FI 723, FI 730 and (CS 602 or 605) Option A (CS 230 and CS 605) Option B (CS 350 and CS 602)

FI 751. This is to be taken during your junior year summer semester. The Registrar's Office had sent a registration form via email and will register you if you're eligible. Don't attempt to register for this course on your own.
