important REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Please read the information corresponding to your AS program below carefully to ensure a successful registration. Failure to abide by these rules will result in being dropped from incorrect course registrations

Registration FAQ's for all Advanced Standing Program Students

- You can only register for OPEN course sections that you're eligible for.
 - If a section is closed, you're not permitted to add yourself to the waitlist unless it's a designated Advanced Standing section. You will be **removed**.
- You **can't** take more than 4 total graduate courses in your Advanced Standing program during your undergraduate pathway. **If you've already taken 4, don't register this semester.**
- You **can't** register for courses you've already taken the UG course equivalences for. Please review the course equivalences list on the Registrar site [here](#).
- You **can't** register for GR 500 level foundation courses, BID, BILH, HC, HF, PWE, PMF PML or PMW or AL online course sections unless specifically advised to do so by your program director.

Accounting

Review the graduate Accounting majors [here](#). Knowing your intended graduate program major is **necessary** in your graduate course selections.

New ASAC students - Register for the following:

- AC 611-3 take instead of AC 311.
- AC 730-1 take instead of AC 340

If you need course planning assistance please connect with Program Director, Len Pepe and/or an academic advisor.

Business

For BS Majors:

- Take **GR602-1** instead of CS 305
- Take **GR604-2** instead of MG 300
- Take 2 MBA Electives instead of 2 Electives

For BA Business Studies Majors:

- Take **GR601** instead of a Business Elective
- Take **GR602-1** instead of a Business Elective
- Take 2 MBA Electives instead of 2 Electives

In Degree Works: You can view the four shared graduate courses at the bottom of your degree audit under BS- Joint Program. Please be sure to hit the Process New button to refresh your audit.

Business Analytics

The four graduate courses are: **MA610, ST625, CS605, and MA705.**

- ST625 replaces MA252;
- CS605 replaces CS350;
- MA705 replaces MA346.

If MA252 is a major/minor requirement, take ST625 junior year.

Finance

You can only register for **Finance** courses that apply to your program tract. Review the catalog [here](#).

FinTech majors: The four graduate courses options are:

FI 623, FI 723, FI 730 and (CS 602 or 605)

- Option A** (CS 230 and CS 605) *OR*
- Option B** (CS 350 and CS 602)

FI 751: should be taken during your junior year summer semester. The Registrar's Office will register you if you're eligible for the summer.
