Orientation Leaders (OLs) are responsible for helping welcome all new falcons to our diverse Bentley University Community. OLs must be knowledgeable of University resources and the various opportunities available to incoming students. OLs will assigned a group of new students (including first-year, transfer, and exchange students) to mentor during the Orientation Program and beyond. It will be the responsibility of the OLs to create a community within their groups through icebreakers, conversation, information and motivation. They will lead new students to sessions, facilitate small group conversations, fill any unexpected down time in schedule, and be the primary resource during our program. Successful candidates are school spirited, passionate, comfortable leading icebreakers, skilled at managing different group dynamics and many personalities as well as patient/flexible. In addition to leading their groups, OLs are responsible for various operational tasks (based on individual abilities) to ensure the successful completion of the Orientation Program.
